

Democratiseun Letter to Mr Tony Benn, Dated: 27.01.2009

Dear Mr Benn:

For the sake of brevity we attach our letter to the secretary general of United Nations with regards to the democratisation of that organization and also their reply, a brief mission statement of our campaign and finally our letter to the president elect of the United States of America Mr Obama the contents of which letters we hope is self explanatory, and all of which relate to our firm belief that this important institution needs to be radically restructured.

We hope, if you agree with this campaign, and approve the basic idea, you will support and indeed guide and lead us in the right direction with a view to achieving some meaningful progress in our ideals.
